After being lifted up from the pit, his brothers sold Joseph to Midianite traders for money. Then in Egypt, one of Pharaoh's officials and the captain of the guard, named Potiphar bought Joseph from the Midianite traders. Potiphar was pleased with Joseph's behaviour and character. But his wife did not. She used to harass and scourge him whenever she got a chance. By believing his wife's lies about Joseph, Potiphar put Joseph in a prison.

He was imprisoned along with two officials of Pharaoh; one was the king's chief cupbearer and the other one his chief baker.



One night, both the officials in the prison had different dreams. Without knowing the meaning of their dreams, each of them became very sad. Joseph asked them, "Why you both look very gloomy today?" "No one is here to interpret the meaning of our dreams," and they replied. And Joseph said to them, "Don't all interpretations belong to God? Please tell them to me."



Dream of the Baker (Teacher reads from Genesis 40:16-19) Dream of the Cupbearer (Teacher reads from Genesis 40:9-13)

Joseph prayed to God and explained them the meaning of their dreams. The meaning of the dreams was that the baker would be hanged up and the cupbearer would be restored back in Pharaoh's office within three days. On the third day, just as Joseph had interpreted to them, the chief baker was hanged and the chief cupbearer got his job back in Pharaoh's palace.

Two years passed by. One night the king of Egypt Pharaoh himself had two different dreams. But both the dreams were more or less similar.



(Teacher reads aloud from Genesis 41:1-8)



Then the chief cupbearer said to Pharaoh, "My Lord, the imprisoned young Hebrew named Joseph has a talent given by God to interpret the meaning of dreams. When I was in the prison, I had a dream; he interpreted it and so it turned out as he said."


Then the king ordered, "Bring Joseph to me now itself."








"Lord God, do not punish us, but help us and liberate us."


Having heard their cry, God appeared to Moses in a burning bush and said to him, "The cry of the Israelites has now come to me; I have also seen how the Egyptians oppress them. So come, I will send you to Pharaoh to bring my people, the Israelites, out of Egypt." But Moses said to God, "O my Lord, who am I that I should go to Pharaoh, and bring the Israelites out of Egypt? I have never been eloquent; I am slow of speech and slow of tongue." Then God said to him, I will be with your mouth and teach you what you are to speak. Take with you your brother Aaron; he indeed shall speak for you to the people."

As God commanded him, Moses went to the palace of Pharaoh. His brother Aaron was also with him.

Listen to the Conversation:







Since Pharaoh did not obey the command of God, his elder son died. Besides, every Egyptian family was struck with the death of firstborn child. Pharaoh became very sad. He called Moses and Aaron, and said:

A great misery has smashed on my country. There is not even a single house without someone dead. I am afraid of your God. And now, you rise up, go away from my people, both you and the Israelites

Thus Moses, the leader of Israelites, had delivered the people of God from the exile of Pharaoh; and he led them to Canaan.



After Israelites had gone out of the Land of Egypt under the leadership of Moses, they came into the valley of Mount Sinai. Then God said to Moses, "Let the people stay down at the valley; and you alone come up to the mountain." When Moses went up to the mountain, God gave him two tablets of stone and said:

Moses, Moses, here are the two stone tablets having Ten Commandments written on it, written with my own fingers.

Keep it with you.




TEN COMMANDMENTS

Israelites were travelling through the desert or wilderness of Sinai. Moses and Aaron were leading the people. They were going to the land which was assured by God to be given, the Promised Land of Canaan. God, who was always taking care of His people, had delivered them from the bondage of Pharaoh and was leading them to Canaan. During daytime, God covered the sun by a pillar of cloud that they wouldn't be tired of its hot and heat rays. While in the night, God went in front of them in a pillar of fire to give them light and protect them from severe cold.

But the army of Pharaoh pursued the Israelites. When the people of Israel reached the Red Sea, they mumbled each other and wept in great anxiety, saying, "What should we do now? In front of us is Red Sea, and behind is the army of Pharaoh, where should we go?"

God had come for their help. Obeying the command of God, Moses lifted up his staff and stretched out his hand over the sea. Suddenly the waters were divided into two sides, forming a wall for them on their right and on their left. Then Israelites crossed the sea through dry land and reached the other side. When Pharaoh's army entered into the dry land, the waters from both sides came back into its normal depth and covered the entire men of Pharaoh; not even a single one escaped.

Israel crossing the Red Sea




Waters from both sides came back and covered the army of Pharaoh, when they entered in to the dry land.

Afterwards, the Israelites continued their journey through the wilderness. When they had no food to eat, they complained to Moses. Moses prayed to God. God gave Manna from heaven for them to eat. They were also provided with quail for meat.



When they thirsted for water, they complained again. Then also Moses cried out to God and God replied him, "Strike the rock with the staff in your hand." Moses struck the rock in the wilderness; and immediately water stared to flow out of the rock. Having drunk enough and satisfied, they continued their journey

to Canaan.



Hence, God had protected His people in wilderness for forty years by providing them food and watertimely.



There were lot of prophets in Israel, and one among them was prophet Isaiah, the son of Amos. Having been born in a palace, his living condition was good, and he received good education.







coming; and when he comes, he will proclaim all things to us.


Jesus: I am he, the Messiah.




This time also Jesus defeated him with the Word of God, saying,






Saul was a Roman citizen involved in punishing and persecuting Christians. He was very educated and worked as a government official. He was the one who had been keeping the clothes of those who had stoned Stephen, the first martyr of the Church. One day he went on to Damascus with the authorized letters of Jewish high priests in order to bring Christians to Jerusalem as captives. When he was approaching Damascus, suddenly a light from heaven flashed around him. He fell to the ground and heard a voice saying to him,



Being afraid of the voice, he asked, "Who are you, Lord?" And the reply came from heaven, "I am Jesus, whom you are persecuting. But get up and enter the city, and you will be told what you are to do."

The men who were traveling with him stood speechless because they heard the voice but saw no one. Saul got up from the ground. He opened his eyes, but could see nothing. He had lost his eyesight. The people with him led him to Damascus and brought him to the house of 'Judas' where he stayed for three days, spending time in prayer without eating or drinking anything.

After three days, the Lord commanded a priest named Ananias, who was a strong devotee of Jesus, to go to Saul. Ananias came to the house of Judas and laid his hands on him and prayed. Immediately something like scales of fish fell from his eyes, and his sight was restored.



Having realized his sins, Saul had repented and accepted Jesus Christ as his Lord and Saviour. Then he got baptized, received the name 'Paul' and became the apostle of Christ. Hence, the persecutor of the church had become its nourisher, who went on to different parts of the earth and preached the gospel of Christ. St. Paul is also included among the disciples of Jesus Christ. In AD 67, Emperor Nero had murdered him by sword, and he became a martyr. And the Church celebrates the commemoration of St. Paul along with St. Peter, the head of the disciples, on June 29 every year.






